Awards and Scholarships Application Form

While not required, interested students are encouraged to complete this application form. All decisions will be announced and awarded at the Undergraduate Awards Day in the Spring semester.

Both graduating and returning students are eligible for the awards. Only returning students are eligible for the scholarships. The Laurie Undergraduate Research Scholarship is divided among all terms that the student is registered for courses during the research period. All other scholarships are divided equally between the Fall and Spring semesters of the next academic year.
